Itsy bitsy, teeny weeny, yellow polka dot... banana hammock?!! Slivers of cloth triangles over the tiniest measure of skin leaving so little to the imagination that one worries about a wave with too much momentum in the near vicinity. A string buried so adeptly that you can critique a great Brazilian wax from 20 paces. These are just a few things you can find on a Key West beach in the heat of summer (which started in May if we're being real here). No complaints. There's no snow. However, now that the snowbirds have all flown north, we have a new flock for the summer. Locals. I count the Miami-ans in this because I like to say that the Keys are their "up north" property. I'm originally a midwestern girl and everyone I knew had a property somewhere in the absolute-nowhere-north of Wisconsin or had a friend with such a property, that they escaped to for a couple of weeks each month in the summertime. We are this for mainland Florida... oh, and Jersey. No explanation for that. Lots of people from Jersey here in the summer. They throw one hell of a cookout at the beach.

Which beach? Fort Zachary Taylor is the local favorite. Speaking of hammocks, Fort Zach has the best trees on the whole island so if you happen to travel with a sling you will not be disappointed here. About a month into being a new islander, Husbutch and I realized that the beach is breathtaking but the shade is heaven and one can only sit on a sandy picnic table bench a few times before you come up with an alternative. The area filled with pines is raised above the beach creating an ideal spot for watching the water and swimsuit fashion show from the comfort of your shaded swing. It may be the best kept summer secret. You're also closer to the grills which is a big plus.

Though Key West is not known for its beaches because they aren't sugary white sand that clings to the tanned behind like a Banana Boat commercial, our beaches come with their own unique set of appealing features. If you visit Smathers Beach on S Roosevelt Blvd (which recently had a very nice facelift), you can walk out hundreds of feet into the water and never get deeper than hip-height. The beach is sand and a great place to walk because it goes on for about a half mile so your fantasy of a beach stroll at sunset is easily realized. This beach is also great for families with littles because you likely won't lose them in the surf. Lounging in an inflatable creature of your choosing is also ideal here. If you'd like to go a bit deeper you just take a short ride (everything is a short ride because we're only 2 miles by 4 miles so you know I mean short) you can park over at Reynold's pier and choose one of several sets of steps into deeper water. There is an old sea wall there teeming with life. Bring your snorkel. And a cocktail.

Other notable beaches here are Higgs Beach with a poignant pier used by locals to jump big waves in the rainy season. There's Simonton Beach with a bar. Turtles sometimes nest there, too. It's small but cute and usually has some nice tropical music playing. Dog Beach is.. a dog beach. The only one on the island and it's conveniently located next to Louie's Backyard so you can get a cocktail with your salty dog time. Oh, and don't miss the only natural sand beach on the whole island. You can play there if you stay at The Reach Hotel or go for brunch on Sundays. And now you'll win at Key West trivia, too.

Of all of the half dozen beaches in Key West though, Fort Zachary Taylor State Park is still my absolute favorite. It has everything. Concessions, rentable chair and umbrellas, showers, flushable potties, the best sunset view in the island and a hammock perch perfect for watching the fluorescent green triangles parade by with no end in sight (because they're buried deep in the... sand). So Lez Go Out and watch the summer heat up from the swinging shaded throne of the beach this summer. Meet me in the pines. I'll be the one with a sun hat and very dark sunglasses enjoying the view..

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
BEACH READS

LGBT Book Reviews by *Terri Schlichenmeyer*



“DIANAWORLD: AN OBSESSION” BY EDWARD WHITE

c.2025, W.W. Norton | \$32.50 | 402 pages



Your head was always meant for a tiara.

Or a crown, maybe both. Elegant clothing was supposed to fill your ample closets and you were meant to have a maid or valet to help you dress. And yeah, glass slippers should be on your feet right now. Then again, being royalty can have its drawbacks: as you'll see in “Dianaworld: An Obsession” by Edward White, it can be a royal pain.

Even as a child, young Diana Spencer was proud of her heritage.

But Davis tried not to think about that. Not on his wedding day. Not, unbeknownst to him, as the Reverend was rushing toward the wedding venue, uninvited but not unrepentant. Not when By the time she was born, White says, “her family [was] a mighty social presence” in Great Britain, with many ties to the Royal Family. Little Diana often played with the Princes Edward and Andrew, and she supposedly met Prince Charles when she was just five years old and he was seventeen.

That age difference meant much less when the Prince was searching for a bride and Diana flirted with him at a “shooting weekend” event. Soon, they were engaged, though they only “spent time together... a handful of times” and the marriage was broken before it scarcely began.

You probably know how it ended, and how her life ended, too.

And yet, nearly twenty-eight years after her death, Diana continues to fascinate people.

Says White, the frenzy over royal-watching compounded when it appeared that the “world’s most eligible bachelor” had found his princess, and the paparazzi were relentless. Every outfit Diana wore was scrutinized, condemned, and mimicked; she was criticized for being candid, and for being overly-drama. She seemed to think that “part of her solemn duty was to appear as the Princess of Wales as often as possible” but she also apparently disliked what happened when she did. She shook up the Royal Family’s status quo by refusing to participate in stiff-upper-lip-ness or emotional distance, and that touched the hearts of many.

Here we are, a generation removed from August 31, 1997, and there is still only one Diana for a lot of people. Those are the readers for whom “Dianaworld: An Obsession” seems to have been written, and you can think about this book in two basic parts.

Author Edward White takes a deeper-than-usual look at Princess Diana’s life, mostly as a Royal, but you’ll also read about her before and her after. Alas, those who arose in the dark to watch her wedding in 1981, or who cried when she died won’t find much new. Heavy sigh. What you will find, however, is a subtle new attitude about Diana, as seen through a backward lens. Gone is the gushing, in favor of facts. There’s snark here, and some degree of gossip but it feels fresh, maybe because the blast of Diana books has been a trickle in the last decade. We’re not inundated with Diana, so this book feels right, right now.

Despite that, forever fans of the Princess will get the most out of it. And if that’s you, well, you know the assignment. “Dianaworld: An Obsession” is a book to wrap your fingers and your head around.

"I love getting all glammed up! The wigs, the costumes, the jewelry, the shoes... I love it all!"

Does Faith Michaels have a catch phrase?

"I have 2 of them- 'NAILED IT!' and 'Son of a bitch!'"

June was Pride month so let's talk about your life as an out member of the LGBTQ+ community. When did you officially come out?

"I came out right after high school. Everyone already knew way before I even knew but I didn't want to make my life any more

What does Pride mean to you?

"Pride to me is being true to yourself. Proud of yourself. Not ashamed to be yourself."

If you could tell the younger generations coming out or struggling to find their identity one thing, what would it be?

"I would tell the younger generation that they need to be focused on what makes them happy. Not trying to do everything for someone else. It's your life. You have to live it your way and do what makes you happy."

What inspires your creativity during these difficult and trying times in the world?

"The main thing that inspires me during these times is remaining proud and positive and remembering all what I have accomplished in my life and how if I would have hid in the shadows, I would not have what I have today."



If you could teach the world a lesson about drag culture to help them better understand, what would it be?

"The most valuable lesson you could teach the world about drag culture is that we are all artists. We are all doing a piece of art for you to share with you, to connect with you."

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


