September in Key West is when the island shifts her weight, tosses her hair, and says, "Alright ladies, it's your turn." Womenfest arrives like a glittery, sun drenched queer migration — a week where the island becomes a full scale lesbian playground, complete with pool parties, sunset sails, drag shows, dance nights, and that unmistakable hum of sapphic joy vibrating through every street. If August is intimate, September is electric. It's the month when Key West feels like she's hosting a reunion for every queer woman who's ever loved her.

Womenfest has a way of transforming the island overnight. Suddenly, everywhere you look, there are couples holding hands, friend groups in matching tank tops, and solo travelers who came for "a little vacation" and end up leaving with twenty new best friends. The energy is magnetic — the kind of energy that makes even the locals walk a little taller, smile a little wider, and remember why this island is such a haven for queer women in the first place.

The days start with pool parties, where the sun is high, the music is loud, and the vibe is pure lesbian summer camp. You see every flavor of queer woman: the sporty ones already halfway through a seltzer at 11 a.m., the artsy ones floating on unicorn rafts, the couples who swore they weren't going to be "that couple" and are absolutely being that couple. There's something beautiful about watching strangers become friends in the span of a single afternoon — sunscreen shared, chairs pulled closer, laughter echoing off the water.

And then there are the excursions, the ones that make Womenfest feel like a true Key West experience. The sunset sails are legendary — a boat full of queer women drifting across the Gulf as the sky melts into pink and gold. It's impossible not to feel romantic, even if you're single, even if you're just there for the drinks and the breeze. The ocean has a way of softening everyone, making conversations deeper, smiles easier, and connections feel inevitable.

Daytime adventures take on a special glow during Womenfest, especially when you head out with Lazy Dog Adventures. Renting kayaks or paddleboards

becomes a social event — a flotilla of lesbians weaving through mangroves, laughing, splashing, pretending they're outdoorsy enough to do this every weekend. Their day tours are peak September magic: warm water, shady mangrove tunnels, and that perfect mix of adventure and flirtation. It's impossible not to bond with the people paddling beside you, even if half the group is secretly hoping someone else will steer.

But the nights — the nights are where Womenfest truly shines. Drag shows packed with queer women cheering so loudly the performers beam. Dance parties where the DJ knows exactly what the girls want. Bars overflowing with couples, singles, friend groups, and that one woman who somehow knows everyone. The island feels alive in a way that's uniquely feminine, uniquely queer, uniquely Key West.

Queer-friendly restaurants glow during Womenfest. The conversations are louder, the laughter richer, the sense of community unmistakable. You see familiar faces from past years, new faces who instantly feel like part of the family, and couples celebrating anniversaries, proposals, or just the joy of being somewhere that feels like home. September is when the island's queer heartbeat becomes impossible to ignore — steady, strong, and full of love.

And through it all, Key West herself seems to lean in. The breezes return. The sunsets stretch longer. The nights feel softer. The island becomes a backdrop for connection — romantic, platonic, spontaneous, long awaited. Womenfest isn't just a festival; it's a reminder of what this island has always been for queer women: a sanctuary, a celebration, a place where you can show up exactly as you are and be met with warmth. September in Key West is loud, joyful, sweaty, romantic, chaotic, and deeply tender. It's the month when the island belongs to the girls — and the girls belong to each other. 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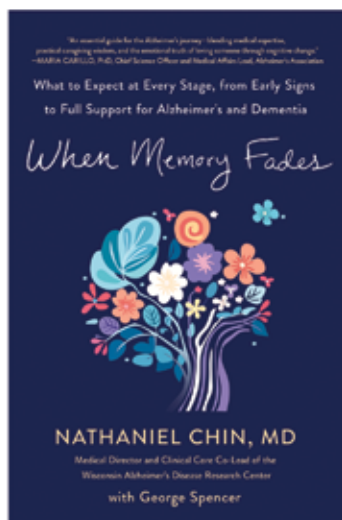

"WHEN MEMORY FADES: WHAT TO EXPECT AT EVERY STAGE, FROM EARLY SIGNS TO FULL SUPPORT FOR ALZHEIMER'S AND DEMENTIA" BY NATHANIEL CHIN, MD

Mom called you in a panic the other day.

She'd lost her keys and by the time you arrived to help, she'd found them.

In the refrigerator.

These kinds of things keep happening, not often but often enough, and you don't know quite what to worry about. But in the new book "When Memory Fades" by Nathaniel Chin, MD, you'll learn about the journey ahead, for both of you.

You can't remember why you walked into a room. You got lost last week, going to

the bank. Popular wisdom says that things like that are normal as we age, but Chin says that's not true – although the answer may not be a worst-case scenario, either. Yes, memory problems could just be signs of stress, dehydration, or lack of sleep – or is it time to see a doctor?

Chin says maybe, yes.

He was working his way through medical residency when his father, a geriatrician in Madison, Wisconsin, was diagnosed with Alzheimer's. Chin, now a geriatrician, was blindsided, but that diagnosis also changed his life.

Here, he writes about the brain, and how Alzheimer's and dementia are diagnosed, explaining that dementia has many faces and,

depending on a doctor's evaluation, memory problems might be slowed or improved. He shares his father's illness with readers, but he also writes about his mother, a steadfast, steady caretaker.

Her story reminds reader-guardians to care for themselves, too.

Know how to talk the talk, so that you can have "a more productive" conversation with your doctor. Understand that there's nothing "normal" about dementia or Alzheimer's. Know the statistics – African Americans are affected with dementia twice as much as whites – and know how to lower your risks. Learn here what questions to ask, how to break the news to everyone, and any legal matters that will be important soon. And know how to tend to you.

Says Chin, "The best action you can take is to educate yourself... The more you understand, the better equipped you are to make sound judgments."

Something's off about Dad, just a lot of little things that don't add up. When is it time to step in? "When Memory Fades" can help you decide. Wise, wide-spread, comprehensive, and compassionately helpful, this is a book you can read and then take it to the doctor with your loved one. It's a book that makes sense when nothing else does, and its biggest feature is that it smoothly transitions from easy-to-grasp science and charts, to gentle coaching for caregivers. Author Nathaniel Chin, MD writes with storytelling, humility, grace, and experience from both sides of the Alzheimer's/dementia issue, and his words are reassuring but also urgent. Learn, but don't wait, he says. Know how to safeguard yourself. See your doctor, and don't fear testing. Watch for signs of depression. And never, ever stop asking for help.

Read those last seven words, and find "When Memory Fades" now. It's a book to have on your shelf, whether you're 45 or 95 because, as you'll see, dementia happens and knowledge is key.

But I wonder, now, if all Webber musicals are about to become interactive in these ways. Will the next one be *Starlight Express*: the whole second act takes place on the A train. The homeless people

get to be the ensemble. It will still cost \$375 for a seat and a return fare is NOT included with your ticket price.
